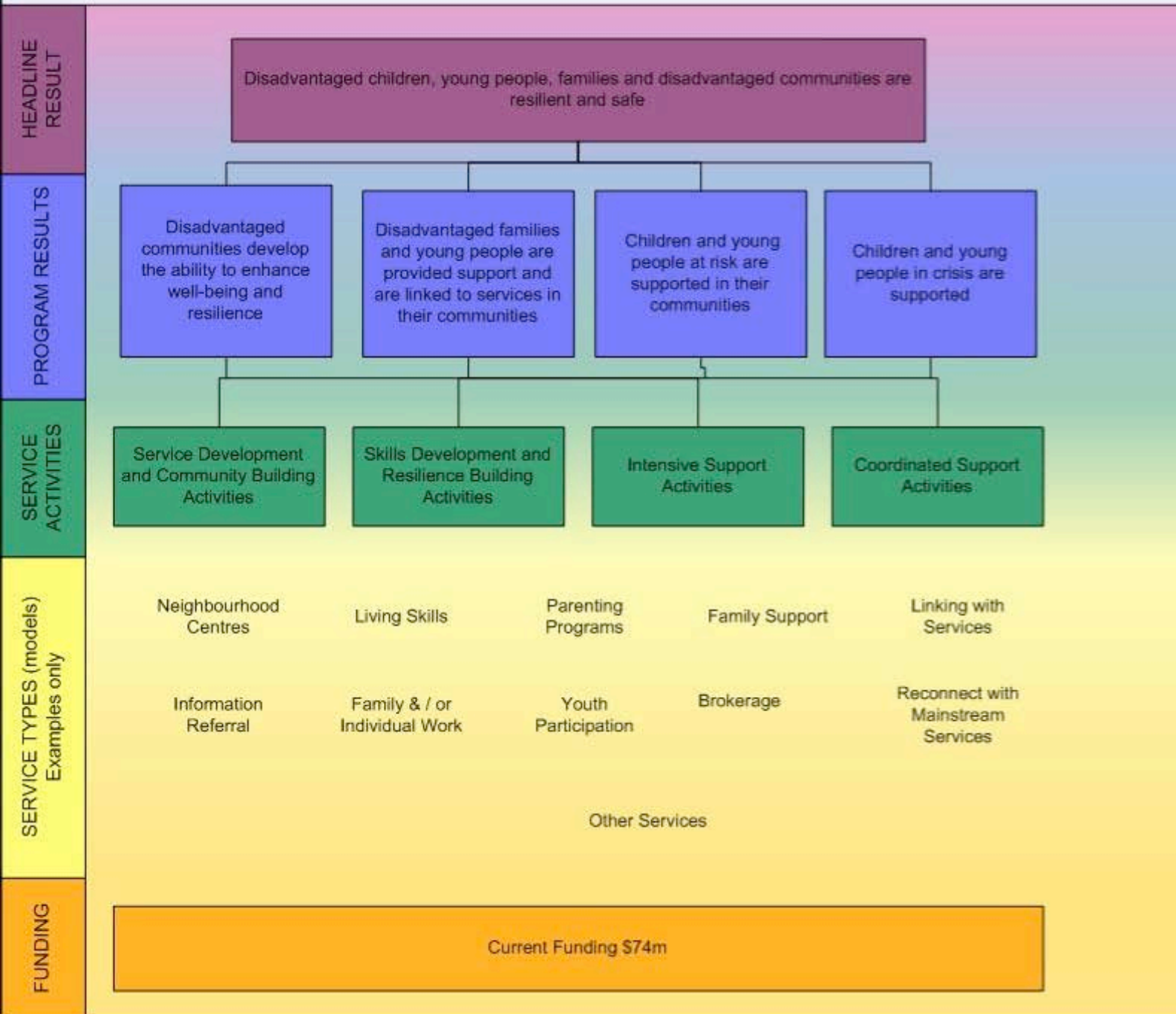


# COMMUNITY SERVICES GRANTS PROGRAM



**TARGET GROUP:**  
Disadvantaged children (0-16) and young people (12 -25 years), their families and disadvantaged communities.

**DEFINITIONS:**  
**Disadvantaged:** Disadvantaged children, young people, families and communities experience circumstances or conditions that seriously impact on their resilience and safety or impact on their life chances.

**Family:** A family is a group of two or more people, one of whom is the carer of a child or young person in the group. Other members of the group must either be children, young persons or persons involved in caring for the child/ren or young person within the group.

**Community:** Groups of people who share a common sense of belonging which may include living in the same place, having common interests or sharing a similar age or culture.

**Resilience:** Resilience is a pattern of good adaptation or development in the context of significant adversity or risk. People are described as resilient when they exhibit evidence of adversity or risk and good functioning or outcomes in spite of these hazards. Resilience is not a trait or a permanent condition. A particular person may be resilient at one time and not at another.

**Safety:** Safety is the condition of being protected against social, emotional or physical harm.
